BOAT SCHEDULES

From Cleetwood Cove, on opposite side of the Lake from
the Lodge

From opening through June 30th, Tours leave at 9:00 a.m. -
11:00 a.m. - 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. If 20 people or more, will
leave sooner.

July 1st through Sept. 5th, Tours leave approximately every
hour. First boat leaves 9:00 a.m. Last boat leaves 3:00 p.m.

Sept. 6th through Sept. 11th, Tours leave 9:00 a.m. - 11:00
a.m. - 1:00 p.m. - 3:00 p.m. If 20 people or more, will leave
sooner. Season closes Sept. 12th.

Includes 10 minute stop at Wizard Island. Allow yourself about
one hour to drive from Lodge and walk down trail. Trips last
two hours.

The intense, azure blue waters of world famous Crater Lake provide a spectacular view from the rim, but a launch trip around the 25-mile shoreline gives an even deeper appreciation of this geological phenomenon.

The entire trip takes 2 hours and all trips are narrated, some by ranger-naturalists who point out distinctive geological formations of the caldera at close range as well as lava flows, underwater fumaroles and other distinguishing features — none of which may readily be seen from the rim.

The Cleetwood Cove dock is directly across the lake from Crater Lake Lodge, where motorists will find ample parking facilities. From the parking area, a 1.1 mile trail, known as Cleetwood Trail, leads to the Cleetwood Cove dock.

A view of Crater Lake — from any single spot — stirs emotions of visitors to this Cascade range wonderland — but to make the 35-mile Rim-Drive with a driver-guide who provides running commentary throughout the two-hour trip is a never-to-be-forgotten experience.

The buses carry only 10 passengers, making a small intimate party of every Rim-Drive.

Frequent stops for taking pictures will give you the opportunity to recapture the beauty of world-famous Crater Lake long after your trip is concluded.

The 35-mile Rim-Drive allows a spectacular view of Crater Lake and its 25-mile shoreline. The lake has been plumbed to a depth of 1932 feet. From the rim, the azure blue color (and it is an ever-changing blue) offers a sight which will never be forgotten.

The driver describes geological formations and points out interesting landmarks.

Arrangements may be made in advance to participate in the launch trips and those making such trips will be picked up by a later bus to continue their Rim-Drive tour. There is no extra charge for this service.
