Advanced tour reservations recommended in the summer. Same-day tour tickets are available first-come first-served; long waits and sellouts are possible, especially in the summer. Call ahead, or stop first at the Illinois Valley Visitor Center, 201 Caves Highway, Cave Junction, Oregon, for current information. The road is winding and slow; plan on a 40 minute drive from Cave Junction. Reservations go on sale March 1, 2018.

Be Prepared for your Cave Tour

The Discovery Tour lasts 90-minutes. The route is moderately strenuous and is not recommended for people with heart, breathing, or walking problems. The entire route is 1-mile with steep ascents and descents, requires frequent twisting and low-bending, and has more than 500 uneven stair steps. The temperature inside the cave is 44°F (7°C).

To prevent the spread of White-nose Syndrome do not bring clothes, shoes or equipment used in another cave or mine.

Surface Hikes

Hike to the Big Tree, climb Mount Elijah, or explore the Cave Creek Trail or Cliff Nature Trail as part of your visit. Trails are open year round.
